Oliver Groene - PhD, MSc MA, is Head of Research and Development at the population health management company OptiMedis AG, Honorary Senior Lecturer in Health Services Research at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, and Visiting Fellow at the Centre for Healthcare Resilience and Implementation Sciences. He holds a Master degree in Medical Sociology (University of Bielefeld, Germany), a Master of Science degree in Public Health (LSHTM), and a PhD in Public Health (University of Barcelona, UPF).

Previous appointments include a seven-year tenure at the World Health Organization where he led the 'Quality of Health Systems and Services' and 'Integrated Care' Programmes, a four-year tenure as Director of Research and Education at the Avedis Donabedian Research Institute, Autonomous University of Barcelona, and a four-year Senior Lectureship in Health Services Research at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine. He served as PI or co-PI on various large scale (EU) grants, with total research funding in PI/co-PI roles over 5 million EUROS. He publishes widely in leading clinical, quality-of-care and health policy journals.

His research papers have been cited more than 1600 times, reflected in his h-index of 24. He has a keen interest in approaches towards improving population health and sees a clear role and responsibility of the health care sector in supporting and collaborating with other sectors in their contribution towards improving population health.
